

Call to Worship

One: As a child, forgotten by his parents at the temple in Jerusalem, Jesus carried these words. As a man calling disciples, he carried these words. As the messiah practicing a ministry of healing, he carried these words, waiting for them to bloom in his own life.

All: We enter this worship aware of what we carry in us that sustains us, and aware of everything that we need and hope for tonight. As we go with Jesus deeper into Holy Week, give us words to sustain us in difficult times.

One: Give us the words, O God, knowing that Jesus has gone before us and will go with us.

All: We enter into this dark hour, eager for its story, trusting that the night will not have the final word.
