One: In seeking to love You more deeply, let us see the paths toward care for our neighbors. Let us see ways that we may become love ourselves.



Feeding Our Children Together (FOCT) - As many of you know, our church participates in this program which provides a bag of food to food-insecure children in the Plymouth Head Start Program and children in the youngest grades in Plymouth Elementary School. Depending on how many families are eligible, we usually pack between 37-52 bags each week during the school year. This year, we will probably start packing in mid-September after both schools have determined who is eligible. Right now we have a few people in our packing program: Linda and Jim LaPrad, Rebecca Larson, Peggy Martin and myself, Alice O'Connor. We usually have about 6 or more volunteers so that no one is scheduled more than twice a month. We usually have 3-4 volunteers each week to pack. So, I am looking for 3-5 additional volunteers who would be willing to pack with us. We pack on Tuesdays at 9:00 a.m. in the lowest level of the Church. It usually takes us about 1 hour to pack. We leave the bags in the food room, and Michael Nicholas, our custodian, transports the bags to the schools on Thursdays or Fridays. If you are interested, please email Alice at alimaenh@gmail.com
