## Scripture for Oct 9, 2022

## A reading from the Hebrew Bible, Commonly referred to as the Old Testament: an adaptation of Psalm 111

- <sup>1</sup> Praise God!
- I will give thanks to God with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation.
- <sup>2</sup> Great are the works of God, studied by all who delight in them.
- <sup>3</sup> Full of honor and majesty is God's work, and this righteousness endures forever.
- <sup>4</sup> God has gained renown by wonderful deeds; God is gracious and merciful.
- <sup>5</sup> God provides food for those who fear; God is ever mindful of the covenant.
- <sup>6</sup> God has shown people the power of holy works, in giving them the heritage of the nations.
- <sup>7</sup> The works of God's hands are faithful and just; all God's precepts are trustworthy.
- <sup>8</sup> They are established for ever and ever, to be performed with faithfulness and uprightness.
- <sup>9</sup> God sent redemption to the people;
  God has commanded this covenant forever.
  Holy and awesome is God's name.
- <sup>10</sup> The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it<sup>\*</sup> have a good understanding. God's praise endures forever.

## A reading from the gospel of Luke 17:11-19

11 On the way to Jerusalem Jesus<sup>\*</sup> was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. <sup>12</sup>As he entered a village, ten lepers<sup>\*</sup> approached him. Keeping their distance, <sup>13</sup>they called out, saying, 'Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!' <sup>14</sup>When he saw them, he said to them, 'Go and show yourselves to the priests.' And as they went, they were made clean. <sup>15</sup>Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. <sup>16</sup>He prostrated himself at Jesus'<sup>\*</sup> feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan. <sup>17</sup>Then Jesus asked, 'Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they? <sup>18</sup>Was none of them found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?' <sup>19</sup>Then he said to him, 'Get up and go on your way; your faith has made you well.'
