A reading from the Hebrew Bible, Commonly referred to as the Old Testament: an adaptation of Psalm 111

¹ Praise God!

I will give thanks to God with my whole heart,
in the company of the upright, in the congregation.

² Great are the works of God,
studied by all who delight in them.

³ Full of honor and majesty is God's work,
and this righteousness endures forever.

⁴ God has gained renown by wonderful deeds;
God is gracious and merciful.

⁵ God provides food for those who fear;
God is ever mindful of the covenant.

⁶ God has shown people the power of holy works,
in giving them the heritage of the nations.

⁷ The works of God's hands are faithful and just;
all God's precepts are trustworthy.

⁸ They are established for ever and ever,
to be performed with faithfulness and uprightness.

⁹ God sent redemption to the people;
God has commanded this covenant forever.
Holy and awesome is God's name.

¹⁰ The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom;
all those who practice it* have a good understanding.
God's praise endures forever.

A reading from the gospel of Luke 17:11-19

11 On the way to Jerusalem Jesus* was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. 12As he entered a village, ten lepers* approached him. Keeping their distance, 13they called out, saying, 'Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!' 14When he saw them, he said to them, 'Go and show yourselves to the priests.' And as they went, they were made clean. 15Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. 16He prostrated himself at Jesus* feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan. 17Then Jesus asked, 'Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they? 18Was none of them found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?' 19Then he said to him, 'Get up and go on your way; your faith has made you well.'
