This year we finished a house in Plymouth for a very happy client, started building another house in Plymouth, purchased a burned-out house in Plymouth that we will demolish and rebuild, received three donated building lots in Ashland and one in Sanbornton, plus two lots we already own in Franklin. The Ashland lots are now in the closing process. We have a lot of work to do!
